## **DRAFT POLICY DOCUMENT 6 September 2006**

### **WEBSITE INCLUSION**

### **CHURCHES DIRECTORY, LINKS PAGE and EVENTS DIARY**

#### **1) INTRODUCTION**

Glasgow Churches Together offers inclusion on its website's Churches Directory, Links Page and Events Diary as a service to the Christian community in the Greater Glasgow area.

Glasgow Churches Together offers this service in good faith, but does not necessarily endorse the content of external websites or events organised by bodies other than Glasgow Churches Together.

All inclusions on the Glasgow Churches Together website Churches Directory and Events List are at the discretion of the GCT Website Subcommittee.

Glasgow Churches Together is a joint initiative in the Greater Glasgow area by the:

- Church of Scotland
- Methodist Church
- Roman Catholic Church
- Salvation Army
- Scottish Episcopal Church
- United Free Church
- United Reformed Church.

Glasgow Churches Together works closely with denominations, congregations and local ecumenical groups within the City of Glasgow and in adjoining areas within the Church of Scotland Presbytery of Glasgow and/or the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Glasgow.

Glasgow Churches Together encourages all Christian churches, congregations, communities and organisations to actively pray for and strive for Christian Unity.

We encourage ecumenical involvement at all levels: personal, local, regional, national and international – especially locally here in the Glasgow area.

## **2) INCLUSION in the CHURCHES DIRECTORY**

Listing in the Churches Directory is generally open to Christian churches, congregations or communities in the Greater Glasgow area who:

- confess God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and
- can demonstrate an active engagement in, or bona fide openness to, the work of Christian Unity.

The Churches Directory provides basic contact information: name of church / group; title of contact person; address of meeting place; telephone number, email and website.

- We do not list personal names and times of church services.

## **3) INCLUSION on the LINKS PAGE**

Links to individual churches' websites can be found on their dedicated page in the Churches Directory.

Other Development / Education / Charitable Organisations with Christian roots and ecumenical openness may request a link from the GCT website to their own.

If a web-link is requested, we ask that this be reciprocated and clearly accessible.

## **4) INCLUSION in the EVENTS DIARY**

Generally, events included are to be ecumenical in nature and content.

Events may include services, celebrations, lectures, social initiatives and the like.

Events organised by GCT, Local Churches Together groups and other ecumenical bodies may be listed.

Special events, celebrations or initiatives within a GCT member denomination or congregation or other Christian body may be listed.

Appropriate interfaith initiatives and public service information may be listed.

Other requests for events listing will be decided on a case by case basis.

This Draft Policy Document on Website Inclusion for the Churches Directory, Links Page and Events Diary was adopted by GCT Committee 6 September 06.
